*Additional Regulations made by the Governor in Council under section 2 of the Emergency Regulations Ordinance, 1922, Ordinance No. 5 of 1922, on the 2nd day of March, 1922.*

---

Taking possession of coal, firewood, and food stuffs.

10.—(1.) It shall be lawful for the Director of Public Works, or for the Captain Superintendent of Police, or for any person authorised thereto by either of the said officers, to take possession of any coal, firewood, or foodstuffs, and to dispose of the same in any manner which he may consider desirable in the public interest.

(2.) Any coal, firewood, or foodstuffs, taken possession of under the provisions of this regulation and not returned to the owner, shall be paid for at such rates as shall be determined by a board of arbitrators hereafter to be appointed by the Governor.

Restraint to enforce orders to work.

11. It shall be lawful for the Captain Superintendent of Police to subject to any restraint which he may consider desirable any person required under Regulation 6 of these Regulations to do any work.
