Mandarin Resources' Court Application Adjourned

The High Court application by Mandarin Resources Corporation Ltd. This is the date on which the High Court will consider the SFC's petition, presented to the Court yesterday, for an order in relation to MRC, pursuant to section 37A of the Securities and Futures Commission Ordinance ("SFCO") and for an order that MRC be wound up pursuant to section 45 of the SFCO and section 177(1)(f) of the Companies Ordinance, on the grounds that it is just and equitable and in the public interest for the Court to so order.
